Tuesday 25th

There is a **whole army of people** in the church who go unnoticed. Pray for our church Pastoral Coordinator, for the musicians who faithfully enable us to worship each week, for the techy team on the desk and those who enable us to join in with Zoom when we cannot come in person, for the people who welcome at the door, those who keep everything running smoothly. 
Wednesday 26th

Even those under 3 listen to Bible stories and learn through fun and games. Thank God for those who lovingly give of their time so that our children can learn about Jesus and pray that the children will give their hearts and lives to Him.

Monday 10th

The Marriage Course continues today. Pray that everyone who comes will be able to focus on giving each other time and space. Remember too, Astrid and Ben who are leading it, asking for God's blessing. If you know anyone (family, friend, acquaintance) who is struggling in their marriage, why not pray for them right now.



Tuesday 11th

Throughout the week people meet in **Housegroups**. Ask God that folks will not only enjoy close friendship but also meet with Him through the pages of scripture in study and prayer for each other. Ask the Lord to bless the leaders who selflessly give of their time and effort to help us to grow in Christ.

Wednesday 12th

'You have exalted above all things your name and your word'. (Psalm 138v. 2(b)) As **the Life of Jesus course** continues today ask God that everyone will see the real Jesus of the Bible and may they press in to know him better.

Thursday 13th

Losing someone important can be emotionally devastating and even our own feelings may be confusing at times. This can be a very challenging time and people may struggle with uncertainty or fear about the future. As the **Bereavement Group** meet, pray that each person will find comfort and have opportunity to express their feelings.

Friday 14th

After the terrible incident in **Southport**, let us remember the youth of our country, especially those fascinated by violence and harmful content online. Pray for wisdom for those who try to prevent such things and the relatives of the victims whose lives will never be the same again. (Phillippians 4v.8)

Saturday 15th

This morning, the Sussex Gospel Partnership Bible Training Course continues in our church hall. Ask the Lord that all those taking part have no distractions and fully understand what they are being taught. Pray that they store up Biblical knowledge which will enhance their abilities to share the good news.

Sunday 16th

Our young teens meet at **Rooted** this evening. Ask the Lord that the kernel of seed planted in their hearts will grow into a vibrant faith which will last their whole lives and into eternity.

Monday 17th

Jesus said 'You will hear of wars... nation will arise against nation... there will be famines and earthquakes...' (Matthew 24v. 6&7). 2024 seemed to have all of these and more. Ask the Lord in His mercy that **2025** will be a more settled and peaceful year. Pray for those caught up in these situations and ask Him 'What can I do?'

Tuesday 18th

Sharing **Holy Communion** together is always a pivotal part of belonging to Christ. Pray that the people who will be meeting in church today will be



blessed. Also thank God for the dedicated team who take communion to our church members who cannot come to the meetings in person. Ask the Lord that everyone receiving communion will feel very much part of God's family.

Wednesday 19th

Evergreen meets today. We have a few members who live in Care Homes. Pray that they will continue to follow Jesus all the days of their lives. And ask the Lord that the staff will remember to take them to any service which takes place in the care home.

Thursday 20th

Whatever your political persuasion, being a member of **the government** seems a bit like drinking from a poison chalice. Pray for those who rule over us that they will do it for the love of the country rather than self-gain. Ask the Lord to help them to make wise decisions especially when choosing those who are to advise them. Pray also that they will get the right work/life balance. (1 Timothy 2v. 1&2)

Friday 21st

The mops and dusters will be out today as the cleaning team and the flower arrangers do their work in the church. Few of us know them by name but the Lord sees their dedication and hard work. Thank the Lord for them and ask that they may feel the blessing of God as they serve both us and Him.
